

Minutes from UISC Members Meeting on Wednesday, 4/11/07 in Room 341 (the Purdue Room) of the IMU.

The meeting was called to order at 7:37 pm by Commodore Patrick Kresch. There were 16 members attending.

- I. The minutes from the last members meeting on 4/6/07 were read by Secretary Amy Rohlfing. The motion (Hart/Callaway) to approve the minutes as read passed unanimously.
- II. Officer Reports:
 - A. Lindsey Schneider on behalf of Lauren Trolley, Vice Commodore:
 - i. There will be a workshop for volunteers for teaching from 11:00-1:00 at the boathouse this Saturday. Check the email that went out over the listserv for more information.
 - B. Pat Kresch, Commodore:
 - i. Pat failed to send out notification about voting on purchasing boats and dollies, so we will have the final vote next week. He apologizes for the tardiness of his meeting notification email.
 - C. Matias Perret, Co-Fleet Captain:
 - i. The old pontoon boat has been put up for sale on eBay and it is currently at \$510 with the trailer.
- III. Old Business:
 - A. Matias received pictures of the FJ for sale. There are no major or minor damages, no noticeable chips, no fiber glass repairs, and the boat has all the rigging. Matias will bring the pictures next week and will try to get pictures of the sail. It looks like a good boat and Matias recommends that we continue to pursue it.
- IV. New Business:
 - A. John Huntley encouraged the executive officers to make it a goal for the year to encourage more members to become skippers. There is a brand new skippers test on the website and many sailors are already qualified based on their heavy weather sailing ability.
 - B. Welcome to two new club members! Both have sailing experience.
 - C. Matias has a list of all current registration for boats, windsurfers, and trailers. Some of the windsurfers do not appear to be registered, but the newest registration stickers have not been applied yet.
- V. Announcement:
 - A. A power strip with a timer and a shelf have been installed over the work bench for charging radios and power tools.
 - i. The timer on the power strip is an electrical timer, not a mechanical timer. Do not turn the dial all the way around.

- ii. Recommended that all power tools and radios be charged for 13 hours or less.
 - iii. A couple of power tools are much less powerful than intended; however, it is almost more to buy new batteries than new power tools. Tom Hart will try to revamp the batteries one cell at a time.
 - iv. There will be a sign next to the power strip.
- B. There has been progress on the Scamp transmission. New parts or replacements have been found for all worn parts. It looks like we are only waiting on two more seals.
- C. The FJ dollies will cost \$1075 for three dollies. Voting is postponed until the meeting next week.
- D. The team competed in the Neil Memorial Classic at Purdue University last weekend. The team sailed well, when they sailed. It was 33 degrees with winds in the 20. By the end of the day, all lines had ½ an inch of ice on them and we were the only team without drysuits. There were bright spots, but the team was unable to compete efficiently due to lack of gear in the adverse conditions.
- E. Reminder to submit t-shirt designs for the Iowa Sailing Club t-shirt contest. The deadline for entries is June 1st.
- F. The team is having an on-land Open House recruitment on Thursday night at 7:00 pm in the Penn State Room of the IMU. We would like to get some new team members involved before summer since the club on-water Open House has been moved back. The team will be taking out potential new members once as guests. It will be very low key; we did not want a huge deal out at the boathouse that would get a lot of club members involved. We are not expecting a huge pull.
- G. The CPR class is scheduled for next Tuesday. Check the listserv for an announcement later.
- H. Only 5 out of the 20 lockers in the FJ shed have been assigned. If you are interested, contact Tom Hart. The cost is \$5/ year.
- I. Albatross Nominations:
 - i. Warren Darling nominated himself, Daniel Rogge, and Steve Callaway for trying to “help” the crane lift the old scow off the trailer at the dump. The kept pulling on one end while the crane tried to lift the other end, preventing the boat from being removed from the trailer.
 - ii. Matias Perret nominated Daniel Rogge for having his friends visit Iowa City from California and taking them to the dump as a fun Saturday afternoon activity.
 - iii. Pat Kresch nominated Karl Friedrichsen for trying to sail in 30 degree weather with no wetsuit, gloves, or foul weather gear of any kind. He had to drive to Wal-Mart between rotations to buy a pair of gloves.
 - iv. Steve Callaway nominated Pat Kresch for his lack of voting announcements.
